

Board of Trustees Special Meeting: April 2, 2020

Board Members Present: Marsha Bourgeois, Paul Cnossen, Cecile Gaigals, Lavonne Seifert, Pat Stephan.

The Board of Trustees teleconference meeting was called to order by Lavonne Seifert at 11:05am.

This meeting took place via a teleconference method to observe the governor's guidelines of a 6 feet minimum between people and for our own peace of mind.

1. Annual Meeting

All documents pertinent to the "Virtual" Annual Meeting were mailed on Monday, April 1st and should be arriving to you shortly. This mailing contains the information that you would have received had we been able to meet as a group, including a Summary of BOT activities for the past calendar year as well as a Financial Report. Most importantly **your Proxy form** and **Ballot for Trustee are included.** Please note the instructions and proceed accordingly. Every vote counts as the business of the community can only take place with a quorum that represents the beneficial interest.

The ballots will be tallied on April 18th. Candidates will first be notified of the results. The results will be sent to the Unit Owners promptly via email and will be posted in the mailroom

2. Financial Report

There is a CD up for renewal within the next week. Pat moved that funds in excess of \$75,000 (as of the monthly reconciliation) be transferred into this CD. Marsha seconded the motion and it was approved 5-0.

3. Covid-19
